**Synonyms:** *ridicule, mock, taunt, twit, deride, gibe.* These verbs refer to making another the butt of amusement or mirth. *Ridicule* implies purposeful disparagement: “*My father discouraged me by ridiculing my performances*” (Benjamin Franklin). To *mock* is to poke fun at someone, often by mimicking and caricaturing his or her speech or actions: “*Seldom he smiles, and smiles in such a sort/As if he mock'd himself, and scorn'd his spirit*” (Shakespeare). *Taunt* suggests mocking, insulting, or scornful reproach: “*taunting him with want of courage to leap into the great pit*” (Daniel Defoe). To *twit* is to taunt by calling attention to something embarrassing: “*The schoolmaster was twitted about the lady who threw him over*” (J.M. Barrie). *Deride* implies scorn and contempt: *Musical snobs often deride the harmonica as a serious instrument.* To *gibe* is to make taunting, heckling, or jeering remarks: *The child's classmates gibed at him for his timidity.*

# INTRODUCTION

**M**ost people will find some moment in their lives when the urge to shout at someone will lead to a deluge of words from the mouth. It is a strong person who follows this deluge with prim and proper words, never using the colorful and expressive words considered by society as profanity. (Well, a strong person would ideally NOT express their feelings of anger, frustration, or stress through words at all, instead “walking away” from the situation.) But we are prone to expressing ourselves, often times, in the most severe, blatant, powerful way possible. Profanity gives this expression of self some power and force. Though it may be empty power and inappropriate force, it is the sociably common road taken now. It is hard to NOT use words like fuck or damn when they appear everywhere. It is not to say that using these is right, but right and wrong seem rather fluid, changing from one person to another.

**W**ell, the words that follow may not be acceptable to all. Certainly they will offend some. Some of the words listed are indeed offensive, crude, and obscene. Still, they can aid in the venting of anger, frustration, and hostility. Having a collection of over 700 words may provide some alternatives that perhaps express these frustrations, hostilities, and heated moments in better, less offensive, or less blatant ways. The hope is that this collection will offer alternatives; alternatives that could provide better alternatives without reducing their potency. There may even be some words here that will serve better than standards. That would be welcomed. Dick, ass, and bitch do tend to be over used.

**O**ne beauty of using alternatives to common invectives is they can be even more descriptive, powerful, and direct while not causing immediate offence. They may make the recipient think. They may make the speaker seem educated. There may be some room for thought rather than for angry retaliation. Even if it only provides a different way of saying something, then it has served. Sometimes there is a different, maybe better, way to say something. The list that follows could have that different way. Some of these words could provide a better way of saying something. Sometimes one of the words listed here will serve even better than the words that fall into those “four-letter” word list. Maybe a word here will just be more colorful.

**O**ne thing that will not proliferate these pages are compound words. No Lard-Ass, dick-head, or dumb cluck. Such words have been avoided. There are some, but these do not make the bulk of the list. The trouble with these is that there can be so many combinations that it would overwhelm an endeavor like this. Now the joy here is that JOINING words listed here together can serve to energize or strengthen otherwise mundane insults. Some of the words here are beautiful by themselves. They are direct, powerful, and smart. Imagine adding two together. What marvel of wisdom they will impart.

**A**nd note, there are no pronunciation notes nor grammatical indicators in use here. There could have been, but then this would have taken a too technical, too somber of a tone. Pronounce as seems right and use as you see fit. If said with enough authority, people will accept as correct.

**S**o, see what is here that can replace what you use now. See what is available to express that ire within –and make you sound professional, educated, and sensible. See how you can say what your heart feels while sounding like you are using your brain. There are some powerful words here. Some just call out to be thrown at individuals deserving more than a simple four-letter word. Some reflect such elegance, such depth. Some will impart that insult, invective feel without being seeing as crude, boorish, or foul. Unbind yourself from four letters and go forth and insult with class.

# A

- Aberrant..... This could be well used on someone who was odd, abnormal, or just plain deviating from what you would consider normal.
- Abhorrent..... Disgusting, loathsome, or make you want to bath after being near them.
- Abomination..... Like abhorrent, this applies to someone who causes you disgust. Someone who just isn't a team player or a conformist –in a bad, nasty way.
- Absent-minded..... Someone who is preoccupied with something, but in a major, socially weird way.
- Abstracted..... Like the above absent-minded fool, preoccupied and/or lost in thought in a way that removes them from society and social acceptance.
- Acrimomious..... Bitter and sharp in tone and/or language. You know the type –you just want to slug them to shut them up.
- Addlepatad..... Sure, it means eccentric, but also mixed up and confused.
- Affectless ..... An unfeeling, cold, emotionless person.
- Afreet ..... An evil spirit or gigantic and monstrous demon in Arabic mythology –surely you know a person who fits the description.
- Ailurophobe ..... A hater (often out of fear) of those cuddly, warm felines... cats.
- Alterity..... Being radically alien, as in a weirdo and social outcast.
- Anorexic..... Most commonly associated with super skinny, but it also applies to a severe economy of style, as in miser.
- Apostate..... As a noun it refers to a deserter, recanter, avoider, or heathen.
- Arrogant..... If you think your poop doesn't stink or you make claims that are unwarranted or important yet think they are or are just regularly overbearing, your arrogant.
- Ass..... No offense to the Donkey (family Equidae), this can refer to one who shows their ass through actions, words, or thoughts.
- Assenter..... This is not so bad: to agree or concur. But too much too easy implies a weakness that can warrant ridicule and insult.
- Asshole..... See ASS above. This just gives it more oomph like emphasizing that you aren't just a little one but a WHOLE one.
- Asswipe..... Well, kind'a like ASS and ASSHOLE, but suggesting a lack of backbone as well.

# B

- Baboon..... Again no offence to the monkey, genus Papio, this applies to a brutish, somewhat foolish person. See BOOR.
- Baleful..... You could use this on an overbearing in-law or a horrible, scary boss, it relates to being ominous or portending evil.
- Banal..... Think BORING. It refers to someone drearily commonplace and often too predictable. Think trite with a face.
- Bantam..... A small but aggressive person. In some cases it may not come off as an insult, but use you can just picture that evil, hateful little person who fits this just perfectly.
- Barbarian..... Brutal, crude, cruel person, either in speech or actions. Insensitive and uncultured.
- Bastard..... In good company it just denotes someone born of infidelity or out of wedlock. Used one that piece of garbage you just can't stand and it takes on new, harsher meaning. Then it intones the individual's own short comings. Bad shortcomings.
- Befuddled..... This would be that person fitting the "caught in the headlights" look: confused or perplex. Sometimes that confusion comes from too much indulgence in alcohol.
- Beggar..... Once just a man or boy, it is more common seen with a person who asks for alms and is or appears to be impoverished (sometimes in dignity or self-esteem).
- Beldam..... Think: witch. An UGLY, old woman, though once it denoted respect towards a lady and was rooted with grandmother.
- Belligerent..... Aggressive and hostile. Thinking that they know it all and are always right adds to this word's gravity.
- Bigot..... Partial to one's own... whatever (group, religion, race, etc.) I see bigot people; they're all around me.
- Bitch..... Right, female dog, but also so much more, yet rarely forgetting it's female connection (nor it's repulsive connotation).
- Blatant..... Unpleasantly loud and noisy. Just outright offensive and obtrusive.
- Bloody..... Sure, it has blood in it, but it can be used with the feeling of filthiness and repulsion.
- Blubbery..... Ahhh... fat. Just BIG. The dress doesn't make you look blubbery, you are just FAT.
- Blubbering..... That annoying, want to drown noisy sobbing. Cry.
- Bombast..... Though it officially refers to writing or speech that is over the top, grandiose or pompous, it can be used with a person (who perhaps is the author of that writing).
- Boor..... A person with rude, clumsy manners and lacking social refinement. Think barbarian.

Bore..... A word with many meaning that can be used to refer to someone that is dull, tedious and repetitive.

Bozo..... Like the clown, but more foolish. A dunce (but also, in some cases, just a fellow).

Blubbering..... Crying, sobbing, lamenting –think: that fool sobbing over nothing.

Blunderer..... A blunder is a serious mistake. The one who makes that mistake, usually out of sheer ignorance, stupidity, thoughtlessness, and confusion is the blunderer.

Brazen..... Flagrant and insolent audacity. Shameless. There is also a hint of harshness.

Brute..... A beast, in a not so good way. A crude, insensitive, brutal person.

Buffoon..... Another clown but not a good one. More ludicrous or bumbling than funny. A fool.

Bugger..... This relates to annoyance and pestering.

Bullheaded..... Obstinate. Foolishly or irrationally stubborn.

Bum..... Not the back side but a vagrant, tramp, good-for-nothing person.

Bumpkin..... Think yokel. An unsophisticated, awkward person.

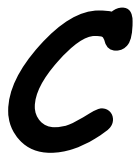
Bungler..... An inept or clumsy person. Like that player who can't catch and hold the ball.

Bunyip ..... Sure, it can mean an imaginary monster inhabiting swamps and lagoons, but it also fits people who are fake –like an imposter.

Bur ..... Like the seed that sticks to you, this works too with a nettlesome, persistently clinging person.

Bureaucrat..... Often related to politics it deals with rigid devotion to details to the point of absurdity or annoyance.

Buttinsky ..... A meddler. A person who is prone to butting in.



Cad..... That crude, unprincipled, brutish person with no manners or sensitivity towards others.

Cadaverous..... This could be used for a gaunt, emaciated person or one who use pale to the point of corpse-like pallor or to an odor so strong as to suggest death and decomposition.

Caitiff..... A wretch and a despicable coward.

Canaille..... Rabble and riffraff like dirty pack of dogs. Scum or dregs of society.

Cantankerous..... An ill-tempered and quarrelsome person. Very disagreeable or difficult to handle.

Capon..... A castrated male chicken, so good for a weak male or a male with eunuch like qualities.

Capricious..... Impulsive and unpredictable, often selfish characteristics.

Cavalier..... While meaning gallant or chivalrous qualities it also can refer to an arrogant, dismissive disregard showing contempt towards others, like 'I know all and my poop don't stink' attitude.

Chaffer..... A trickster giving to good-natured teasing who also may engage in banter. A haggler, too, which makes it more insulting.

Chameleon..... A person who changes with the situation –in a too frequent, questionable way. Like a turncoat or harlequin.

Charlatan..... A fraud or quack. This is that person who asserts greatness or makes elaborate claims of skill or knowledge.

Chary..... Cautious and wary to the point of being tightfisted and absurd.

Chauvinist..... Prejudiced and narrow minded.

Cheat..... Dishonest practice of fraud. Swindler.

Chicken..... Coward. I guess it could also refer to a person who is sickly pale and clammy skinned... who just doesn't strike you as being right.

Chinchy..... Tightfisted, cheap, and stingy.

Chump..... A person who is seen as stupid or foolish. Like a dolt.

Cicisbeo..... Smarmy ladies' man or gigolo. Seducer.

Clacker..... A person given to thoughtless, prolonged chatter or empty talk.

Clochard..... A vagrant or tramp. From Vulgar Latin once meaning lame person.

Clod..... A dull, stupid person. Just like dolt. A lump of a person (or lump of clay).

Clown..... Not funny but foolish. Maybe they think they are funny, which adds to their issue.

Clumsy..... Well, so not well coordinated or sharp of mind, action, or emotion.

Clunk ..... This is a nice way of saying stupid –for that dull, dimwitted person.

Cockney..... Referring to a city dweller or pampered child due to social status and origins.

Cocky..... Self-confident or overly self-assertive. Full of themselves. You know the type, all bluster and hype but little substance.

Colored..... Used derogatorily, referring to people of black/dark complexion. Similar to nigger.

Comedian..... Like Clown, usually meaning not being particularly funny or amusing.

Con..... A swindler, given to fraud. It's relation to Convict is fading to obscurity.

Conceited..... Unduly high opinion of one's self. Full of self. Other meaning as much less caustic.

Condescending..... Thinking of self as superior and treating others in a patronizing and superior manner.

Confused..... Well duh! This person doesn't know what is going on. Ever!

Conniver..... A plotter and a schemer looking to skirt rights proper ways.

Contrarious..... Perverse and contrary to sociable acceptable.

Contrary..... A person given to willful, perverse, irritatingly opposing behavior.

Contumacious..... Rebellious and disobedient. Insubordinate. Like a hard to deal with child.

Coquette..... A flirt. A teasing woman.

Cormorant..... A greedy person.

Cotquean..... A coarse or scolding woman. Also a man who is seen as taking one domestic matters traditionally regarded as suitable only for women.

Cow..... Not just the female cattle... but a FAT person.

Coward..... Showing just too much fear.

Cozener..... A cheat or cheater.

Crab..... A quarrelsome, ill-tempered person.

Cracker..... Sometimes seen as a derogatory for a Caucasian person.

Crackers..... If British, it refers to an insane or crazy person.

Crank..... A grouchy person or overly eccentric.

Crazy..... Well, like not right in the head. Loony. Mental Health.

Crapulent..... This is good for a gluten, drunk who does something to excess to the point of sick.

Craven..... Coward. `nough said.

Crass..... Crude and unrefined like someone with no social grace what so ever.

Credulous..... Gullible and easily duped. Like a fool but still likeable.

Creep..... Annoying and unpleasant jerk.

Cribber..... Cheater, especially in writing, like a plagiarizer.

Criollo..... Redneck or hick to a Spanish person.

Critic..... That person that can find nothing good and loves to inflate the bad.

Croaker..... A complainer or nay-sayer or just generally boisterously negative.

Cro-Magnon..... Worst than CRASS; it is a HUGELY crude and unrefined person. NEANDERTHAL.

Derelict..... A bum or vagrant usually homeless AND jobless.  
Desiccated..... Lifeless, dry, lacking spirit.  
Deviant..... Applies to anyone who doesn't conform to accepted norms.  
Devil..... Like DEMON, an evil, tormenting, depraved individual.

Draconian..... Someone who is excessively harsh, stringent, and severe sometimes to the point of seeming violent and savage.

Dreck..... Trash and inferior.

Droll..... A clown or buffoon.

Dropout..... A quitter.

Drudge..... One at the lower levels of society, similar to a slave or social outcast.

Drunk..... Slush. This is more than just the plain, simple intoxicated. This is for the dirty, A.M., falling down, foul-smelling drinker.

Drunkard..... Like the DRUNK described above, this applies to the habitual drinker/DRUNK.

Duck..... An odd-ball. A weirdo.

Dud..... A disappointment. Someone who is often unsuccessful or ineffective.

Duffer..... A peddler of junk or the junk itself –worthless and useless.

Dull..... Boring.

Dullard..... Very boring.

Edacious..... Wolfish, gluttonous, and just outright selfishly voracious.

Edgy..... A nervous Nelly type to the point of being irritating.

Eel..... Slimy and wormy. You know the type. They just give you an uneasy feeling.

Eerie..... Weird. Mysterious but in a very creepy way.

Effeminate..... Girlish when not a girl. Feminine like. Soft.

Effete..... Like EFFEMINATE, girlish, but also associating a lack of strength, will, vitality.

Effluvial..... Waste often seen as a gas or vapor.

Egg Head..... Like a bookworm, an intellectual beyond social accepted standards.

Egocentric..... Full of self. Taking one's own self as center of all. Selfish.

Egoist..... Like EGOCENTRIC, devoted to just the self.

Egomaniac..... As with EGOIST and EGOCENTRIC above, this person is full of themselves –but to an obsessive degree.

Egotistic..... More ego (self) here. This person is conceited, boastful, and selfish.

Egregious..... Offensive by being preposterous, far-fetched, or absurd.

Eldritch..... Like EERIE above, strange and out of the ordinary. Think FREAK.

Elf..... Small. Also, referring to a mischievous, playful child.

Elfin..... Mischievous and sprightly. Fairylike.

Elfish..... Prankish and mischievous.

Elliptical..... Not direct. Skirting truth or reality. Not trustworthy.

Elusive..... Difficult to pin down. Short of being a liar, like a Politician.

Embittered..... Beyond angry and fed-up.

Empoisoning..... Full of venom and anger. Like EMBITTERED.

Emetic..... So offensive as to cause vomiting.

Enigma..... Perplexing, inexplicable, weird, and just plain odd.

Enigmatic..... Bizarre. Weird and puzzling. An ENIGMA.

Eunuch..... Slave, basically. One, a male, who serves almost without a will of their own.

Evasive..... One who tends to avoid or is vague and unclear.

Exiguous..... Tight. Meager. Cheap-skate.

# F

Faggot..... Homosexual.

Faker..... An impostor. One who uses falseness, usually to their benefit.

Fanatic..... Crazy and blind in their support or siding with cause, thing, or person. Usually extreme and unreasonable in their enthusiasm.

Farinaceous ..... Pale; powdery texture/look. Can you picture a person like this? I can.

Fart..... Like the gas, unfavorable and disliked.

Fats..... Big.

Fatso..... Bigger.

Fatty..... Biggest.

Fatuous..... Foolish, unreal, and smugly.

Feckless..... Careless and irresponsible but also lacking purpose or vitality. Weak and foolish, basically.

Feeble..... Weak and inadequate.

Feisty..... Touchy and quarrelsome but also a bit frisky and full of spirit.

Feral ..... This is a wild, animal-like person who is savage in looks and/or manner.

Fey..... Like fairy but with a dark note relating to foreteller of coming death.

Fickle..... CAPRICIOUS or erratic in their affections and attachments.

Fiend..... Evil person like a DEMON. Absorbed and obsessed with something.

Fink..... A SNITCH. A teller; informer. Contemptible from their duplicity.

Filcher..... A thief.

Flabby..... Carrying excessive weight in an unattractive way, but not quite pain fat.

Flagrant..... Offensive or reprehensible.

Flathead ..... This is the name or reference name of a Native American tribe, but has been used to refer to an plain, shallow, sub-ordinary person or group.

Fleshy..... Like FLABBY, it suggests extra body weight but not quite fatness. PLUMP, maybe.

Flincher..... Coward. One who runs away of flinches.

Flirt..... This could be a good thing, but mostly, it refers to a person whose integrity is in question, as she uses her sexuality to seduce and use.

Flivver ..... An old, cheap, small automobile –or a person fitting those characteristics (not the automobile part, duh!).

Floozy..... Like a FLIRT, it refers to a woman who is loose and tawdry.

Flunky..... Someone of weak disposition who is a drudge and too obedient.

Foghorn ..... A booming, insistent voice. Or, A LOUD PERSON.

Fool..... A person who is seen as deficient in judgment, unwise, and perhaps a jester.

Forger..... A person who creates falseness, like a CON.

Foul..... Not a baseball term but a person who is revolting and rotten.

Fraud..... A fake. A cheat. An imposter.

Freak..... Someone who is weird to a high level.

Fuck..... Use this to refer to a sever JERK, a FRAUD, a FLIRT, a FOOL, etc. Anyone who is just extremely objectionable to you.

Fucker..... Much like FUCK, just more errrrrr!

Fuck Head..... One of a few two word terms here, it can be used to refer to a FOOL, a JERK, a CHEAT, etc. Yeah, like FUCK and FUCKER.

Fumbler..... Someone who mishandles something (or someone). Clumsy.

Fussbudget..... A complainer or one who obsesses over little things.

Fusspot..... Just like FUSSBUDGET: a complainer.

Fusty..... Old-fashioned and even mildewy or smelling of decay. Good for that old geezer who is just too creepy to be sociably acceptable.

Galoot..... A clumsy, slow, unrefined, goofy person.

Ganef..... A thief, scoundrel, or rascal.

Gangling..... An awkwardly tall or long-limbed person. Kind of gangly and rangy.

Garbage..... Worthless, offensive, waste of a person.

Gargantuan..... Super big in an obscene way.

Garish..... Loud and flashy, often self-absorbed and conceited.

Gauche..... Tactless, awkward, and lacking social skills.

Gaudy..... Showy in a tasteless way, often being vulgar and lurid.

Gaunt..... Not just thin or skinny but almost dead looking. Emaciated, haggard, and barren.

Gawky..... Awkward and ungainly.

Geek..... Once just an odd, ridiculous person. Now a sociably inept but smart person.

Gelid..... A cold, insensitive person. Icy.

Ghastly..... Shockingly repulsive and terrifying implying death.

Ghazi..... A militant of the zealot type.

Ghoul..... Start as a grave robber, then move to being revolting, morbid, and loathsome.

Gigolo..... A man partaking in sex or escort services for hire

Gimp..... One with some physical, mental, or other handicap.

Gink..... A foolish, contemptible man.

Gip/ Gyp..... A cheat or swindler. A fraud.

Glutton..... One who consumes, takes in, or uses to excess.

Gnarled..... Physically twisted or knotted. Usually this person is also old.

Goat..... A lecherous man. Given to over indulgence in sexual activity.

Goat Cheese..... Use this for something belonging to the GOAT above or to belittle the GOAT even further.

Goober..... Yeah, to a Southerner this is a peanut but to all else, it is a goofy person.

Goof..... Like the GOOBER, it is a silly, somewhat idiotic person.

Goon..... A bully type, thug, oafish person.

Gourmand..... A glutton; over-eater.

Goy..... Disparaging term for a non-Jew.

Grim..... Rigid, unmoving, forbidding, sinister, and dismal. Just not a friendly person.

Grisly..... Gruesome and ghastly. Someone who is best to stay away from.

Grotesque..... A person who is severely distorted from social norms, often in bizarre, monstrous way.

Gruesome..... Frightful, repugnant, disgustingly shocking person.

Gruff..... Of brusque or stern manner. Harsh or boorish.

Grump..... For the cranky, ever-complaining person.

Gullible..... A person who is easy to cheat, dupe, and deceive.

Gunsel..... Yiddish for a gun-carrying hoodlum.

Guzzler..... A drunk. Drinking to greedy, excessive amounts.

Hoodlum..... A thug, gangster, aggressive, violent, criminally inclined person.  
Hooker..... Not T.J. but a plain and ordinary prostitute.  
Hooligan..... A thug, HOODLUM, or young ruffian.  
Hound..... A scoundrel of a person. Contemptible and malevolent.  
Hubris..... An arrogant, overbearing and prideful person.  
Huckster..... A peddler or hawker, often being aggressive, showy, and devious.  
Humbug..... An impostor, a fake, or deceptive person.  
Humdrum..... A boring or dull person, lacking excitement or variety.  
Hussy..... A woman who is thought of as being immoral, impudent, or saucy.  
Hybrid..... A mongrel, mixed, somewhat barbaric person. Not a team player or sociably acceptable.  
Hypocrite..... A deceptive, fraud of a person who is given to saying one thing but following another.

Ignorant..... Unaware or lacking knowledge or education.  
Idler..... A do-nothing. Lacking substance, value, or basis.

Imbecile..... Stupid to the extreme. This is near to NEANDERTHAL status.  
Immense..... Huge beyond imagination, and not always in physical size (THINK: vain.)  
Imp..... A demon, mischievous child, or devilish person.  
Impotent..... This can refer to physical impairment (like sterile or having an erectile dysfunction) but also general weakness, helplessness, or lacking self-restraint.  
Imposter..... A fake.  
Improvident..... A rash, reckless person.  
Imprudent..... A person who is unwise, indiscreet, or blind to possible consequences.  
Impudent..... Shameless and immodest to the point of being offensive. Impertinent.  
Inane..... An empty head person who lacks sense or substance.

Incubus..... An evil spirit looking for sex. A nightmare. An oppressive burden. Sound familiar?

Indiscreet..... Lacking good judgment. Being unwise. Being too rash or tactless.

Indolent..... Lazy, lethargic, and slow.

Inept..... Awkward and inappropriate. Having a lack of good sense or being clumsy.

Infertile..... Incapable of producing. Mostly dealing with sterility but can refer to a person who just lacks... something –wit, gumption, will, etc.

Inimical..... An unfriendly, hostile, injurious, cold person.

Insidious..... Alluring but harmful, treacherous, sneaky person.

Inspid..... Dull and lacking zest, flavor, or excitement.

Insolent..... Insulting, disrespectful, rude, and arrogant.

Insular..... A hermit like person who lives isolated and withdrawn.

Irascible..... A person who is easy to anger or prone to outbursts of temper.

Irresponsible..... An unreliable, untrustworthy person.

Jug Head..... A dummy. A lack-wit. Big head, no brains.

Junoesque..... Large, tall, sort of Amazon woman like.

Lackwit..... Well, a person that seems to lack wit. A dummy or idiot.

Languid..... Weak, slow, listless, and lacking energy.

Lascivious..... Excessive in sexual desires. Lustful.

Lecher..... A male who is lewd or excessive in their sexual indulgence.

Lecherous..... Given to excessive sexual indulgence.

Leggy..... Having long, spindly legs out of proportion with the rest of the body.

Leery..... Suspicious or distrustful.

Lelanous..... Dark in complexion. SWARTHY. Black.

Lemming..... A sort of mindless follower.

Lemon-sucker ..... A hyphenated word, but so good and applicable that I had to use it. It refers to a sourpuss, complainer, naysayer. You know who it applies to.

Leper..... A social outcast or pariah.

Luxuriant..... Showy, excessively florid or elaborate.

Mad..... This person can be angry or crazy.

Maid..... Traditionally, it means an unmarried woman or servant. As an insult it denotes a woman that is prudish, overly meek, or unwanted (physically).

Magpie..... This person is a talker; a chatterer; an annoying blabber.

Malcontent..... A chronic complainer or nay-sayer, dissatisfied with many things.

Malefic..... An evil person. Also one who is a super bad influence.

Malignant..... Someone who is disposed to doing evil. Like a cancer, the person is virulent and malevolent.

Malingerer..... This person is a slacker, an idler, or a shirker of duty.

Martinet..... A person who is extra strict and demanding, like a militant.

Mashuganuh..... Jerk or schmuck.

Mendacious..... An untruthful, lying, false person.

Meretricious..... A gaudy, vulgar, prostitution-like person. Could be insincere or false.

Midget..... A super short person, like a dwarf.

Milksop ..... For that man that lacks courage and exhibits qualities not deemed manly.

Minacious ..... This works well with that THUG. It means of a menacing or threatening nature.

Miscreant..... This person is an evildoer; a villain; an infidel or heretic.

Misfeasor ..... The wrong-doer; one guilty of doing wrong (misfeasance).

Misfit..... A person who does not fit in or can't adjust to their environment.

Misogynistic..... This person has a hate for woman. More than just chauvinistic.

Misogynous..... The character of hating women.

Misoneist..... This person fears and thus often hates change, innovation, or anything different.

Ninny..... A simple minded person who is seen as being soft and effeminate.

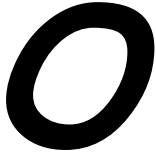
Nocent..... Causing harm. Caustic.

Presumptuous..... Being excessively forward, in a arrogant, unwarranted, assuming way.

Smirch..... Spoiled, dirty, defamed.

Snake..... A treacherous, insidious person.

Sneak..... An underhanded, sly, stealthy, perhaps cowardly, dishonest person.

Snivel..... A whiny, sniffing, complaining person.

Snitch..... A thief or informer.

Snot..... An annoying, arrogant, or impertinent person.

Snotty..... Arrogant and stuck-up like.

Sobersides..... An excessively solemn, muted, severe, stern person.

Softhead..... A foolish person.

Sordid..... Filthy or dirty. Someone foul. A wretch.

Sot..... A drunkard.

Sourpuss..... A habitually gloomy, sad, sullen person.

Space Cadet..... A person who appears to be unaware of their environment or has difficulty grasping reality.

Spastic..... A person given to excessive activity appearing uncontrollable or random. Often foolish, clumsy, and childish.

Spas..... Like SPASTIC, a foolish, clumsy, over-active person.

Spiteful..... A malicious, mean, hateful person.

Spiv..... A slacker, shirking work or responsibility.

Spurious..... A false, not genuine, illegitimate person.

Squealer..... Someone who betrays or turns into an informer.

Squirt..... A small, nonentity, unsavory person. A twerp or jerk.

Stammerer..... Such as a person who can't speak clearly, for whatever reason.

Stickler..... A person who sticks to something without yielding.

Stooge..... A puppet or who allows others to manipulate and use them.

Stinker..... An irritating person or one who is otherwise disgusting or contemptible.

Stinky..... A person of low or bad quality or repute.

Stoolie..... A fink, informer, rat, or snitch.

Stoolpigeon..... A sneak, informer, or knave.

Stray..... A person who has drifted away or strayed from...

Strumpet..... A prostitute.

Stubborn..... Persistent, often difficult to treat or deal with.

Stumbletongues..... A STAMMERER or STUTTERER.  
Stutterer..... Such as a person who can't speak clearly, for whatever reason.  
Succubus..... A demon (often female –descending to have sex with a sleeping, unaware man).  
An evil spirit.  
Suet..... This is the hard fatty tissue around the kidneys of cattle, or a hard, fatty, kind-of  
useless person.  
Sulker..... A spoilsport, moper, or one who sullenly disapproves.  
Supercilious..... Overly proud, showing haughty disdain towards others.  
Swine..... A brutish, contemptible, dirty (in thought or morals) person.  
Sycophant..... A brown-noser, self-seeker who attempts to win favor by flattering influential  
people. Servile. A toady.

Tart..... A prostitute. A sexually promiscuous woman.  
Tartuffe..... A hypocrite, especially one who pretends piety.  
Tattletale..... An informer.  
Tattler..... An informer or turncoat.  
Telltale..... A person who informs on another.  
Temulent..... Intoxicating, poisonous –you know this kind of person.  
Tenebrous..... A dark and gloomy person.  
Tergiversator..... Someone who is evasive, uses ambiguities, or changes sides easily/frequently.  
Termagant..... A shrew. That is a woman that is quarrelsome and scolding.  
Tetchy..... A testy person. Someone who is peevish.  
Thick..... Slow, stupid, stubborn, hard to reach or make see the light.  
Thoughtless..... Careless, inattentive, inconsiderate, or lacking thought.  
Thug..... A hoodlum or cutthroat or ruffian.  
Timorous..... Someone who is timid or apprehensive.  
Tinhorn ..... Important and rich, or at least they think they are. A petty braggart.  
Toad..... A repulsive person, an eyesore, or dog.

Toady..... A person who flatters or defers to others for self-serving reasons. A sycophant.

Tomboy..... A girl considered boyish or excessively masculine.

Tomcat..... A person who sleeps around and is sexually active with more than one partner.

Tommyrot ..... Nonsense. Utter foolishness.

Toothy..... Physically endowed or afflicted with large, prominent teeth not sociably desirable.

Torpid..... Someone who is apathetic, lethargic or inactive. Lazy like.

Torpor..... Showing that state of being mentally or physically inactive or insensible. Lethargy, apathy.

Toughie..... A thug or tough, rough difficult person.

Tout..... A pushy individual often trying –energetically- to solicit others.

Traitor..... A betrayer.

Tramp..... A prostitute or person regarded as promiscuous. Also one who seems aimless; a vagrant.

Trash..... Garbage of a person, regarded as vile, reprehensible, and unsavory.

Treacherous..... Someone not trustworthy, dependable, or likeable. Faithless and dangerous.

Tremulous..... A timid, fearful, quivering person.

Trickster..... A person who plays tricks or likes to swindle others.

Trite..... Insignificant, uninteresting, meaningless, feeble.

Turd..... A piece of garbage or excrement.

Turncoat..... A traitorous person who switches sides.

Turkey..... A person who is thought of as being inept or undesirable.

Twerp..... A contemptible, insignificant, jerk of a person.

Tyrant..... An overly strict, overpowering, harsh, oppressive person.

Unctuous..... Oily, insincere, self-serving, smugly.  
Unhinged..... Deranged, unbalanced, confused.  
Ungraceful..... Lacking coordination or elegance. Being clumsy or ugly in manner or appearance.  
Ungainous..... Greasy in a self-serving, insincere way. UNCTUOUS.  
Unkempt..... Unpolished, shaggy, disorderly, sloppy, rude.  
Unkind..... Harsh, unsympathetic, and severe.  
Unrefined..... Vulgar, rude, coarse, tasteless, and boorish.  
Unwieldy..... Clumsy, difficult to manage.  
Unwise..... Lacking mental acuity or wisdom. Foolish and imprudent.  
Urchin..... A mischievous youth. A scamp.  
Uxorious..... Excessively submissive, especially a man towards his wife.

Vagabond..... A vagrant, tramp, or wanderer. Someone without.  
Vagary..... Given to caprice, whims, inconsistency.  
Vagrant..... Someone without a home. A wanderer, rover, a person constituting a public nuisance.  
Vain..... Excessively proud of one's accomplishments. Conceited.  
Vapid..... Lacking flavor or zest; being dull or flat.  
Varmint ..... An obnoxious, troublesome, undesirable person.  
Velutinous..... Hairy with dense, soft, silky hairs.  
Vermin..... A loathsome or just offensive person.  
Villain..... A wicked, evil, morally corrupt, brutish person.  
Viper..... A malicious, treacherous, venomous person.  
Viscid..... Slimy, mucous, gluey, like a person who is hard to warm up to.  
Vitiate..... To corrupt, pervert, or impair.

Vomica..... The pus in a cavity or putrid matter. Can you think of someone like that?  
Vomitus..... Vomited matter.  
Vulgar..... Boorish, coarse, crude, offensive, indecent.  
Vulture..... A person of a predatory, greedy nature.

Waif..... A homeless person or an unwanted, abandoned outcast.  
Wanderer..... Someone that lacks purpose or moves irregularly.  
Wastrel..... An idler or loafer. One who wastes money or other items of value.  
Weak..... A person lacking strength, will, firmness in character, or energy.  
Weasel..... A person regarded as sneaky or treacherous.  
Weenie..... A weak or ineffectual person.  
Wench..... A prostitute or wanton woman. Sometimes, a peasant or servant.

Xanthippe..... Like a TERMAGANT, this is a scolding, shrewish woman. A spitfire or vixen.

Xanthous..... Callow and deathly looking with light brown or yellowish skin coloring.

Xeric..... Dry and barren like a habitat.



Yak..... A shaggy-haired, somewhat brutish person.

Yakuza..... A criminal, a gangster. One inclined to criminal behavior.

Yammerer..... A whiner and complainer who whimpers and clamors.

Yankee..... A person who shows distinction of a particular, ridiculed, region.

Yap..... A talker or jabberer, usually noisy with stupid talk.

Yegg ..... Although usually specializing in safes, they are still a thief. A burglar.

Yenta..... Lovely Yiddish for a meedlesome, gossipy person, usually a woman.

Yeti..... A large, perhaps hairy person with brutish, crude mannerisms.

Yob..... A hooligan or rowdy, destructive youth. Like a ruffian.
